- Writing: I will continue to write back to anyone that writes to me. You can also buy a cute journal at the dollar store or make books by folding paper in half and stapling it.

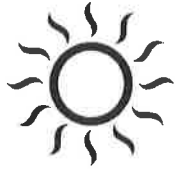
