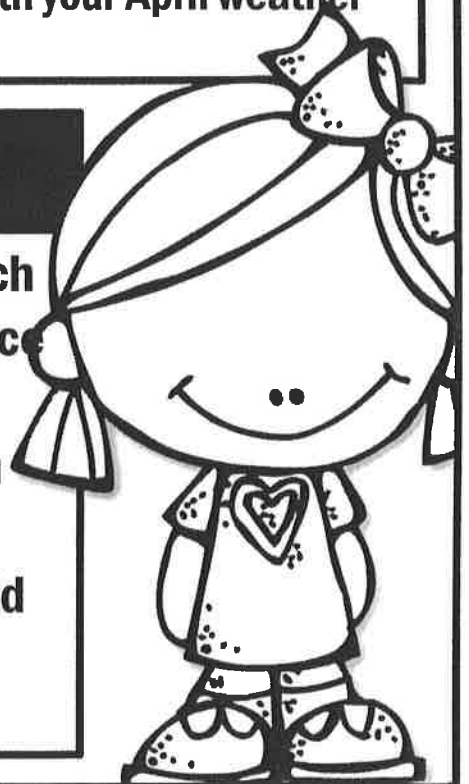
## Social Studies
