

**Campus Community School
Covid-19 Decision Tool for Staff and Students**

Core Covid-19 Symptoms: Fever (100.4 or higher) New or worsening cough New loss of smell and/or taste Extreme fatigue or exhaustion	Additional Covid-19 Symptoms: Sore Throat Runny/Stuffy Nose Stomach Issues Chills Headache
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***Remember to use the daily health screener prior to sending your child to school. If your child has a Covid-symptom not related to a known condition such as asthma or allergies, keep your child at home and contact the school nurse and your family physician.

***If your child is sent to the nurse with a Covid symptom, he or she will be screened by the school nurse. If deemed a potential Covid-case, the nurse will contact the family for prompt pick-up (within an hour). Depending on the situation, he or she will need a doctor's note or negative Covid test to return to school. This will be documented in writing. Family members who attend CCS may also be sent home for further evaluation even if they are not symptomatic.

If your child has tested positive for Covid-19...	If your child has been directly exposed to a confirmed or potential Covid-19 case...	If your child has Covid-like symptoms...
*Do NOT send him/her to school. Do NOT send anyone residing in the same household to school. *Contact Mrs. Greene (heidi.greene@ccs.k12.de.us) to inform her of the situation and discuss next steps. *Follow all DPH guidelines for isolating and quarantining, including for all household members. *Documentation of DPH clearance will need to be provided to the school before returning to school.	*Do NOT send him/her to school. *Contact Mrs. Greene to inform her of the situation and discuss next steps. *If the exposure was to a potential case, your child will need to stay home until the other person gets his/her test results. If negative, your child will be allowed to return to school. If positive, see below. *If the exposure was to a confirmed case, your child will need to quarantine and get tested. Follow all DPH guidelines for isolating and quarantining. Documentation of DPH clearance will need to be provided to the school before returning to school.	*Do NOT send him/her to school. *Contact the school nurse (howard.kimmel@ccs.k12.de.us) and your family physician for next steps. Students must be symptom free without meds for at least 24 hours before returning. Students need a doctor's note when missing school for 3 or more days. *If they develop symptoms at school, and are deemed a potential Covid-case, the child will need to be picked up within an hour of being notified. All school nurse guidelines are expected to be followed before returning to school. *Family members should be closely monitored for symptoms. Sibling decisions will be handled on a case by case basis, depending on the scenario, symptoms, etc.

Quarantine or Isolation: What's the difference?

- **Quarantine** keeps someone who might have been exposed to the virus away from others. Quarantine helps prevent spread of disease that can occur before a person knows they are sick or if they are infected with the virus without feeling symptoms. *People in quarantine should stay home, separate themselves from others, monitor their health, and follow directions from their state or local health department.*
- **Isolation** keeps someone who is infected with the virus away from others, even in their home. People who are in isolation should stay home until it's safe for them to be around others. *In the home, anyone sick or infected should separate themselves from others by staying in a specific "sick room" or area and using a separate bathroom (if available).*

Additional Notes:

- Campus Community School will notify all staff and families if any of its students or staff tests positive for Covid-19.
- For Covid-19 testing information, please visit coronavirus.delaware.gov/testing.
- If your child needs to miss school in person due to quarantining, he/she can join Zoom classes from home and also continue to complete the independent work. This will help your child stay up to date and will allow your child to be marked present. Please contact Mrs. Greene for more information.
